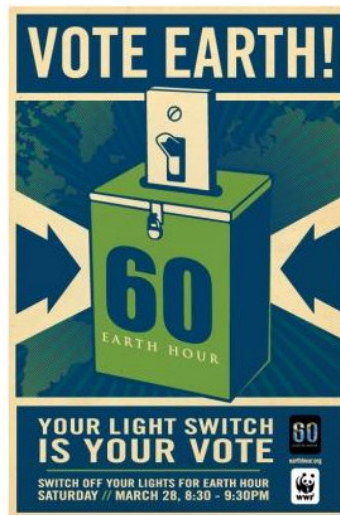
Unite with 1 Billion People for Earth Hour 2009
